In June last year, the Amsterdam Surveyors recommended that, owing to the corroded and wasted condition of the shell plating, etc., the Second Special Survey No. 3 of this vessel, should be carried out as soon as it became due in March 1927.

She recently stranded, and was afterwards placed in drydock at Cadiz for temporary repairs to enable her to proceed to Italy.

The Naples Surveyors now state that the vessel has arrived at Palermo for permanent repairs, but that they are informed by the Owners that it has been decided to withdraw her from the Society's classification.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on Tuesday, the 24th instant, when it was decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
