and to inform you that at the Captains request the non -exclusive
surveyor to the Italian Registry went on board, and made a
preliminary survey and recommendations.

On the matter being brought to our notice, it was pointed
out to the Captain, that in accordance with the agreement existing
between the two Societies, the exclusive surveyor of either acted
for both in the case of such a vessel as this, which was classed in
both registries.

The Captain however informed us in the sense of the above
and in view of the limitation placed on the vessel by the Committee
as shown in the Special Reasons list, special instructions were
asked for.
