Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "TENYU MARU", I beg to acquaint you that in July last the Committee of this Society agreed to your proposal to carry out the Special Survey No. 2, (which became due in December last year), in October.

From a cablegram which has now come to hand from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, it would appear that this Special Survey has not been held as arranged, and I have to say that, in the circumstances, the Committee have to-day given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
