


The class of this vessel is subject to  
permanent repairs being effected to the after peak bulkhead  
and double bottom under boilers at next Special Survey.

A proposal to defer the completion of the  
S.S. No. 2 due 12, 25 until October of this year was approved  
in July last.

A cablegram has now been received from the Kobe  
Surveyors stating that this survey has not been held, that  
the vessel is classed with the Teikoku Kaiji Kyokai (Imperial  
Japanese Marine Corporation), and that they recommend the  
class be expunged with a Red Line.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be  
expunged with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the
