The class of this vessel is subject to an indented plate on the port bilge being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.


The Charterers stated in July last that according to their agreement with the French Government they were compelled to class the vessel with the Bureau Veritas and as they could not afford to support the expenses of the dual classification, they had no alternative but to give up the classification of this Society.

The above decision was confirmed by the Charterers on the 23rd November and the Principal Surveyor for France, who was requested to look into the matter, now states the question of the classification has been discussed with the Secretary of the Contracting Company but the matter is apparently closed and their decision not to be changed.

It is submitted, in the circumstances, the class of the vessel be omitted from the reprint of the Register Book.
