Dear Sir,

S. I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day a communication received from the Society's Surveyor at Auckland, from which it appears you have informed him that it is not your desire to maintain the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steam trawler "SERFIB", and I am directed to say that in view of this intimation instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.

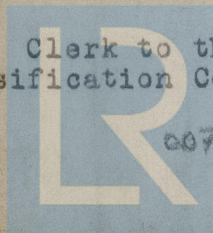
