A Modified Special Survey on this tanker was 1942 and a General Examination in 2,46.

(45 fathoms of chain cable require to be supplied).

The Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Company, in a letter dated 14.2.47, stated that this tanker was to be used as a fuel oil storage hulk at Gibraltar for an indefinite period.

Mr. Barker, of the Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Company, was informed of the proposal to record in this case a notation of "Now used temporarily as a Store Ship", and has stated that the intention of the Anglo-Saxon letter of the 14.2.47 was for the class to be withdrawn as in the case of the Motorship "TRIGONIA".

It is therefore submitted the class of this vessel be from the Register Book and 3 dots (...) inserted in indicating withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.
