When due

The last Special Survey on this vessel was held in 1933, but a Modified Special Survey was held in 1942 at North Shields.

The validity of the present "Examined" notation expires 2.47.

(45 fathoms of chain cable require to be supplied).

The Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Company, in a letter dated 14th instant, state that this tanker is expected at Gibraltar within the next few days, where upon her arrival she will be employed as a fuel oil storage hulk for an indefinite period.

Having regard to the proposed employment of this vessel, it is submitted her class be continued, with the additional notation of "Now used temporarily as a Store Ship".

It is further submitted the Owners be requested to make arrangements for a Modified General Examination to be carried out in order to ascertain the vessel's condition for the service for which she is now required.
