Remarks of Survey

The class is subject to port boiler, port and centre combustion chamber crowns being specially examined before the end of 5.46, to the starboard boiler safety valve chest ^{being renewed} before the end of 5.46, and to the ballast pump water end being renewed before the end of 2.47.

Safety valve chest renewed.

Port boiler, port and centre combustion chamber crowns examined.

The Surveyor recommends part renewal before the end of 2.47.

Minor repair effected.

MS not advanced.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to remain as classed, with record of Survey BS 2.46 ~~as recommended~~ previously withheld, subject to port boiler, port and centre combustion chamber crowns and the ballast pump water end being renewed before the end of 2.47, but without special conditions regarding starboard boiler safety valve chest.
