With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "MEILING", I beg to remind you that letters in regard to the survey which became due on the screw shaft of this vessel at the end of December last were sent to you from this office on the 23rd of March and 31st of July to which no reply has been received. In the circumstances, the Committee, who have had the case under their consideration, direct me to point out that the survey in question is now long overdue and to request that you will state, for their information, what definite arrangements you propose making for it to be held in order to entitle the vessel to retain her class.
