Dear Sir,

With reference to the Glasgow first entry report No. 39288 on three Babcock & Wilcox Boilers No. 495, I have to inform you that these boilers are now reported by the Society's Surveyors at Newport, Mon., to have been fitted on board the s.s. "GURBWILLER" (ex "WAR GRAPE"), Messrs. The Monmouth Shipbuilding Co's No. 366 vessel, the gross tonnage of which is 2572.

The proportion of the total machinery fee due for the survey of the boilers during construction is £14: 5: 9, and I shall be glad if you will arrange to collect this amount from Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox as soon as possible.

I may add that the Classification certificates for this vessel are urgently required, and I shall be glad if you will advise me by telegram immediately payment of the fee for the boilers has been received.
