With reference to your first entry report No.4268 on the Steam Turbines and double reduction gear made by Messrs. The British Westinghouse Electric and Mfg. Co., I have to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Newport, Mon., now report that this machinery has been fitted on board the Monmouth Shipbuilding Co's No.366 vessel, a.s. "GUEBWILLER" (ex "WAR GRAPE").

The proportion of the total machinery fee due for the survey of the engines is £28:11:7, and I shall be glad if you will kindly render an account accordingly to the engine makers. I may add that the certificates on this case are urgently required, and you will be good enough to endeavour to obtain payment at once, and advise me by telegram when the fees have been received.
