The DARTMOUTH Surveyor reports (6.46) vessel placed in floating dock, bottom coated, and on account of damage through heavy weather, a number of defective rivets in centre and side keelsons renewed.

A GENERAL EXAMINATION has been carried out and minor repairs effected.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to have her present records maintained with record of docking survey 6.46, subject as above, and to have notation of "Examined L.R. 6.46" valid for 12 months assigned.
