Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 15th instant respecting the Steamer "CAPAFRIC", from which the Committee note that this vessel has been purchased by your goodselves for breaking-up purposes, and I have to say that in the circumstances and in view of the fact that she will not be submitted for the requirements of the Second Special Survey No.3, which became due under the Society's Rules in September 1926 they have given instructions for her class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
