This is to Certify that

at the request of Messrs. Mitsubishi Denki Kaisha, Ltd., Nagasaki, attend at their works, on the 25th September 1934, in order to examine under test, One shunt wound, direct current, 3.5 K. W. Motor, No. 15186, of 220 volts, by 20.4 amps, at 2600 revolutions per minute, for Circulating Pump.

This Motor ordered by Messrs. Mitsubishi Jukogyo Kaisha, Ltd., Nagasaki, is intended for their Vessel No. 582.

The Motor was submitted to the following tests:-

Full load test of 5 hours duration.
25% overload test of 2 hours duration.
50% overload test for 1 minute.

The rise of temperature was measured by thermometers and on completion of trials, high voltage (2000 volts, A.C.) and insulation tests were carried out, and all found satisfactory.
