Dear Sir,

m.v. "OKSYWIE".

I have to advise you that the above vessel is at present on the Floating Dock at the Stocznia Gdanska, Gdansk, undergoing considerable repairs to the bottom plating and renewing the main engine crankshaft.

The A strake plating (s.s.) has been almost completely removed, the major part of B strake and a considerable number of plates in C strake. Many floors, intercostals and tank ends have been marked for fairing or part renewal. Recommendations were made by the Polish Classification Society, Polski Rejestr Statkow, but now the P.R.S. surveyors have refused to have anything further to do with the vessel. The Owners have stated that they will replace the shell plates under the supervision of their own Superintendants and asked that the Society's surveyors examine the repairs at an early drydocking. I have advised the Owners that this is not possible because repairs have not been carried out to the Society's supervision and also the steel used has not been tested.
