I have to inform you that there appears to be some misunderstanding regarding the working pressure of the boilers of the above mentioned vessel.

The Register Book gives the working pressure as 200 pounds. The Engineers of the vessel maintain that the working pressure is 220 pounds and during the recent inspection by U.S. Government Inspectors a test pressure of 330 pounds was applied.

I shall be much obliged if you will inform me which pressure is correct, in order that I may inform the Owners Superintendent accordingly.
