Dear Sirs,

With reference to the plan left at this Office by Mr. Gray, of the boiler of the s.s. "WESTLAND" now named "BALFARNIC", and with regard there to I have to acquaint you that the machinery of this vessel will be accepted for the original working pressure of 180 lb. per square inch, and a notation of LMB (with date) without the distinguishing mark \oplus assigned, provided the working parts of the engines be opened out, examined and found in good and safe working condition and in accordance with the Rules; the sizes of the line shafting be such as can be approved; the boilers be examined throughout, their scantlings be as shown on the plan, and the boilers be found in good and safe working condition, and the pumping arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

I shall be obliged if you kindly forward for consideration particulars of the line shafting and a plan of the pumping arrangements.
