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This vessel was built in 1913 by Messrs.  
The Rotterdam D.D.Co and classed with the Bureau Veritas.

The Owners now desire this Society's  
classification.

With steam reciprocating engines having cyls.  
21½, 33 and 57 inches dia. by 39 inches stroke,  
W.P. 180 lb. per sq.inch, the size of crank shaft shown  
on the plan, viz- 11.1/4" dia. meets the requirements of  
the Rules for the above working pressure.

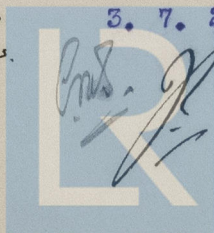
The scantlings of the boiler as shown on the  
plan meet the requirements of the Rules, in force at the  
time the vessel was built, for the original working  
pressure of 180 lb. per sq.inch.

It is submitted that provided the working parts of  
the engines be opened out, examined and found in good and  
safe working condition and in accordance with the Rules;  
the sizes of the line shafting be such as could be approved;  
the boilers be examined throughout, their scantlings  
be as shown on the plan, and the boilers be found in good  
and safe working condition, and the pumping arrangements be  
in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, the  
machinery of the vessel might be accepted for the original  
working pressure of 180 lb. per sq.inch, and a notation of  
LRC (with date) without the distinguishing mark \* assigned.

Particulars of the line shafting and a plan  
of the pumping arrangements should be submitted for  
consideration.
