ALTERATIONS ON VESSEL REVERTING TO OWNERS' SERVICE NOVEMBER, 1946.

No.4 hatchway 8'3" x 6'0" closed in by strongly constructed steel deckhouse riveted to hatchway coaming, with two teak doors (operated from both sides) leading to crew's accommodation in after 'tween decks. (Doorways 58" x 24" with 19" sill).

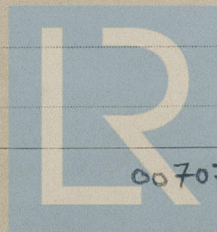
Steel companion between Nos.1 & 2 hatchways leading to original crew's accommodation in forward 'tween decks, now converted for use as a deck store, original openings in upper deck being plated in.

Flush bunker scuttles not permanently attached secured by permanent chain attachments.
