I have to acknowledge the receipt of Mr. Edgar's letter of the 31st ultimo respecting the case of the T.S.S. "ROBINA", and the contents have been carefully noted.

It is observed that the Owners have decided not to proceed further with a view to obtaining the figure "1" for equipment, also that you have informed them, at their request, that provisionally the vessel's class will be amended to read SA- "For Service in Belfast Lough", but that this will be subject to confirmation by the Committee.
