Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th instant from which I note that the Owners of the steamer " ROBINA " have been informed by the Board of Trade that the International Load Line Act, 1932, does not apply to this ship while engaged in Steam 4 limits or as a tender to ocean liners.

In these circumstances and also in view of the fact that freeboard is not a condition of the class of this ship, I have to request that you will arrange for the freeboard marks on her sides to be deleted, and for the certificates to be returned to this Office for cancellation.
