
In reply I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners that provided the service is confined to the smooth water limits as defined on Page 303 of the Board of Trade Instructions as to the Survey of Passenger Steamships, 1928, freeboard assignment is not required. If wider exemption is desired on account of the ship's service, application should be made to the Board of Trade.

I may add that the question of this vessel's equipment is being looked into and a further communication on the subject will be sent you in due course.
