We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 388 building by Messrs. Uruga Dock Kabushiki Kaisha for Messrs. Nippon Yusen Kabushiki Kaisha of 7,300 G-Tons. Length 136,000 Breadth 19,000, Depth 10,500 intended to be Classed ✱ 100 A.1., ✱ L.M.C. and ✱ R.M.C.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
