H. Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee had under their consideration to-day a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Grimsby in which they state they have received no reply to several communications made to your goodselves in regard to the boiler survey and survey of the screwshaft of the steam trawler "ELITE". In the circumstances the Committee desire me to point out that the boiler survey became due so long ago as June last, while the period of time within which the screwshaft should have been examined (at the large end of the cone) expired at the end of last month, and to request that you will state for their information what definite arrangements you propose making to hold these inspections in order to entitle the vessel to retain her class in the Register Book.
