We beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 20th instant, with regard to the trawlers owned by Messrs. Queen Steam Fishing Co. Ltd., and in reply thereto have to advise you that the undersigned this morning interviewed the Owner on the question of continuance of the Society's Classification. This gentleman explained that owing to present conditions he wished to adhere to his decision to withdraw the vessels from class until after the war when the matter will probably be reconsidered. He added that his relations with this Society always had been and still were of a very satisfactory nature and wished us to emphasise the point in our reply to you.
