I duly received your letter of the 21st ultimo, respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of "TRAIN FERRY No.1", "TRAIN FERRY No.2" and "TRAIN FERRY No.3", and having submitted the same for the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting to-day, I am directed to acquaint you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the vessels' characters to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof in each instance, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the classes of these vessels, the records of the freeboards assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
