The Second Special Survey No. 2 became due in March 1923 and the Boiler Survey in August 1923.

These surveys have been allowed to be postponed by the Committee from time to time.

In May last the Committee had before them a letter from the Society's Surveyor at Rio de Janeiro stating that the vessel had recently been at that port discharging, but that he had been informed by the Owners that owing to the large number of Steamers they had laid up under repair it was impossible to stop this vessel. The Owners added that they would do so as soon as possible, as she required a general overhaul and repairs. In reply, the Rio Surveyor was requested by cablegram to inform the Owners that the overdue surveys must be held by the 15th July or the vessel would lose her class.

The Classing Committee again had the case before them on Friday, the 18th instant, together with a cablegram from the Rio Surveyor intimating that the Special Survey had not been held as required, and in the circumstances it was decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (7.24), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
