Five Ferro-Concrete Vessels  
to Creston Shipping Co. Ltd. (Messrs.  
Leighton, Ltd. Managers) have been laid up  
past, under the usual undertaking required by the  
in such cases.

The first four-named vessels are all overdue for  
a further Special Survey, the Special Survey No. 2, although  
no Special Survey No. 1 has been held in any case, and, in  
accordance with the recent decision of the General Committee,  
the Owners were asked to arrange for the outstanding Special  
Surveys to be carried out forthwith in each case for the  
maintenance of class.

In the other five cases, the year of grace allowed  
by the Committee in each case expired more than twelve months ago,  
and in accordance with the Committee's decision referred to  
above, the Owners were asked to arrange for the vessels to be  
generally examined by the Society's Surveyors with a view to the  
continuance of their classes for a further period of twelve months.

The Owners now state that, in view of the Committee's  
decision, it is not their intention to submit any of their  
vessels for examination, and in these circumstances it is  
submitted that the classes of all nine vessels be expunged from  
the Register Book with a red line ( ) in each case,  
indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
