The Newcastle Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and the bottom cleaned and coated. The decks, casings, hatches, peaks, tween decks, machinery spaces and bunkers, etc. have been examined and some minor repairs effected.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 11,23, and notation of Annual Survey Shl.-11,23.
