Nature of Survey

The Newcastle Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated, and minor repairs effected in way of the bilge.

Some repairs have also been effected on port side of keel owing to damage sustained through fouling the cable of <sup>a</sup> ~~the~~ steamer.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 1.21, as recommended.
