With reference to your letter of the 30th ult., we beg to state that this matter has been taken up with the Owners who, however, inform us that they are not at present in a position to sign the Undertaking form as the vessel has not yet been released to them from the Admiralty. They add that she was sent to Great Yarmouth for reconditioning but facilities at that Port appear to be limited and the vessel seems to have been laid up to be reconditioned at some future date.

The Owners have been pressing the Admiralty to have her transferred to the Tyne, though they are not very hopeful of the result, but in any case she remains in the possession of the Ministry until the reconditioning and handing over.

As soon as the reconditioning is actually commenced it is the desire of the Owners that the Special Survey etc., should be carried out.
