Nature of Survey


The Falmouth Surveyors now report this vessel has been placed in dry dock for reconditioning, the bottom cleaned & coated, 1 shell plate renewed & 2 faired in place, the riveting & caulking of shell overhauled, bulwarks repaired, hatches & fittings replaced, fish room cleaned & refitted, rigging &c. overhauled, and vessel refitted for fishing purposes.

15 fathoms of chain cable of proper size & test &c. supplied.

The sole piece of stern frame, slightly scored, has been built up by electric welding.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 10.19.
