F I am directed to inform you that in 1946, the Ministry of Transport advised this Office that the Lighter "VIC 54" had been taken over by the Naval Stores Officer, Portsmouth, and was manned by Yard Craft Personnel.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to let me know whether it is desired to retain this vessel's present Load Line Certificate, and if so, I have to say that An Annual Load Line Survey is now long overdue, and should therefore be carried out as soon as possible.

In this connection, I shall also be glad to learn your intentions respecting the Classification of this vessel, and think it well to point out that the Tailshaft Survey became due in December, 1947.
