Your letter addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Dundee on the 17th ultimo regarding this vessel has been forwarded to this office and the case has now received the consideration of the Committee.

As you are doubtless aware, the 4th Special Survey No.1 became due so long ago as May 1943 and in April 1944 a number of repairs were recommended on account of thin shell plates and wasted deck plating and bunkers, and in view of the fact that it is not proposed to carry out the requisite repairs the Committee regret they have had no alternative but for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Black Line, indicating that on account of reported defects she is no longer eligible to retain her class.
