Agreement was given 12.3.48 for an Interim General Examination to be held valid for 6 months only (see correspondence).

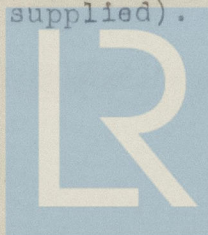
The PIRÆUS Surveyor reports (4.48) the vessel examined in dry dock, bottom coated, the requirements of a GENERAL EXAMINATION (6 months) complied with and minor repairs effected.

Corroded 'D' strake plating (p & s) examined and found efficient meantime.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to have record of docking 4.48 and notation of "Examined L.R. 4.48" valid for 6 months. These records are subject to (corroded 'D' strake plating (p & s) being specially examined at the next dry docking and to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied).
