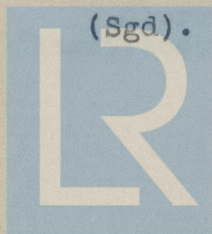
In connection with the surveys for full classification with the Society in the case of former German vessels, such as the "HERMOUPOLIS", "TINOS", "RODOPI", and now entered in the Register Book with the notation "Examined L.R.", it will have been noted that the Managing Committee of Greek Reparation Vessels, which is the managing body, have, in each case, asked for extensions in which to carry out these surveys.

The reason is that the Greek Government, which are the present Owners, have decided to sell these vessels by the end of the year and they desire to leave the matter of the carrying out of the full classification surveys to the new Owners.
