the Owners' Representative survey the steamer "FALK", 1459 tons gross of Stettin, (formerly classed with the Germanischer Lloyd) on the 4th November 1946 and subsequent dates, and that the following parts of hull and machinery were examined afloat, viz:-

All closing appliances in connection with Load Line Assignment examined.

Freeboards (as assigned by Germanischer Lloyd) verified.

Equipment of hawsers and ropes examined.

Electrical installation megger tested.

and that we shall transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report stating that all repairs recommended by us have been completed to our satisfaction, and that we will recommend that she be assigned a Record of "EXAMINED L.R. 10.46" in the Register Book, as previously recommended, indicating that, from the parts seen, she appears to be in an efficient condition for a period of 12 months from October 1946, subject to corroded "D" strake shell plating port and starboard side being specially examined at next dry docking, 30 fathoms of anchor cable being supplied and water gauge valve on shell of boilers being replaced with cocks at the first opportunity.
