The cases have received the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting to-day, and I am directed to acquaint you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the character of each of the following trawlers to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request, viz.:- s.t. "DENTARIA", "FORWARD II.", "GREAT ADMIRAL", "HUGELIA", "JANUS II.", "KING FREDERIK III.", "LADAS", "LYSANDER", "MINORU", "PAVLOVA", "SWEEPER", "THE TETRARCH", "XYLOPIA" and "ZONIA".

With regard to the cases of the trawlers "BROMELIA", "ESCALLONIA", "KING ERIK", "KING HARALD" and "WAR WING", I have to point out that the classification of each of these vessels has already been dealt with by the Committee.
