Dear Sirs,

A. With reference to the cases of the Steel Drifters "MELODY" and "MORN" built by Messrs. The Kings Lynn Shipbuilding Co., the engines of which vessels were made by Messrs. Alfred Doddman & Co., Ltd., I have to inform you that an account for the fees for the survey during construction and installation on board of the machinery of these vessels was duly forwarded to Messrs. Dodman & Co., who now inform me that in both cases the work in connexion with the fitting on board of the engines and boilers was carried out by your goodselves, and point out that the proportion of the fee for this work is therefore not their liability.

In accordance with the agreed arrangement with the Admiralty the fee for the installation on board of the engines and boilers of this type of vessel is £4:10:0, and I enclose herewith accounts for this amount for each vessel, and shall be glad to be favoured with a remittance in settlement at your early convenience.

I may add that the issue of the Classification Certificates for both vessels has been delayed owing to the non-payment of the fees, and Messrs. Dodman & Co., have now promised to forward a cheque in settlement of the full fees payable by themselves, and I shall therefore be glad to receive your remittance in settlement of the amount which is your liability in order that the Certificates may be forwarded to the Registrars of Shipping at Leith and Aberdeen, who have made application for the same.
