Provisional Freeboard Certificate

This is to Certify that

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owner's Representative survey the Steel Screw Steamer

"H. C. FOLGER"

7086 tons gross, for the purpose of issuing Provisional Freeboard Certificate pending the issuance of an International Load Line Certificate from this Society.

The present freeboards assigned by this Society have been verified with the expiring certificate.

The vessel is now having a change of owners and port of Registry. The new owners being Lloyd Brasileiro and the new port of registry is Rio de Janeiro. The vessel is proceeding to that port where it being understood that within the next six months that application will be made to this Society for the vessel to be surveyed with a view to renewal of the Load Line Certificate.

In my opinion the vessel may safely sail until the above mentioned survey has been carried out, the freeboards being:-

Center of the disc below top of steel deck at side	6' - 5-1/4"
Tropical above center of disc	6-3/4"
Fresh water above the center of disc	7-1/2"
Winter below the center of disc	6-3/4"
Winter North Atlantic below center of disc	11"
