Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 2nd July last and subsequent report No. 23425 on the steamer "KATANGA", it is concluded that as the General Examination and the Load Line Renewal Survey, which have been the subject of previous correspondence, are outstanding, these matters will receive attention, concurrently with the boiler repairs, on the vessel's return to your port about the end of the present month. I shall be glad to receive your confirmation to this effect.

I have to add that following your survey in July last the boiler Survey was advanced at Swansen and to complete this inspection mountings of all boilers require to be examined, furnaces and combustion chamber back plates of port boiler to be renewed, wasted combustion chamber back plates in starboard boiler to be reinforced and all safety valves to be adjusted.
