In reply to your letter of the 10th instant, about various first entry reports of ships not yet traced the following:

"KAREL" - "WESTERBEEK" - "WARSAWA" - "ZESTICA". All the Surveyors are on the alert but no further news yet.

Tug "HEROS" went to Germany in 1942 and was managed there by Messrs. "Bugsier" of Hamburg. When last heard of she was used in the Baltic.

As regards Rpt. 29042, my 'a' letter of the 7th inst., gives some further indication and the name "KARUTEN" under which name she left here during the occupation.

As regards Groningen 1st entry report No. 109 on m.v. "XAVIER DORSCH" Mr. Wehrmeyer is investigating.
