NOTE OF PROTEST

M. S. "BEECEELITE"

On this 3rd. day of November, 1938, before me Bernard Leitch Johnson, a Notary Public duly commissioned and sworn, personally came James A. Rankin, Master of the Motorship called the "BEECEELITE" of Vancouver, B. C. of the burden of 209 Net Registered Tons, or thereabouts, laden with Petroleum products, and saith that he sailed from Vancouver, B. C. on the first day of November last bound to Victoria, B. C. via ports.

When leaving dock at Otter Bay, North Pender Island, vessel struck submerged object and fearing damage thereby.

And arrived at this port of Vancouver, B. C. the third day of November, 1938, but fearing damage, enters his protest in due form of law, to serve as occasion may require, reserving to himself the right to extend the same at time and place convenient.
