Messrs The Sunderland Shipbuilding Co Ltd, Sunderland.

Dear Sirs, No 222 s/s.

I undersigned, Robert Bigo of Calais, beg hereby to declare that the vessel building to my order by the Sunderland Shipbuilding Co Ltd, under the yard number 222, is intended for a general cargo and coasting trade, that the doors of the bridge front will always be kept closely shut and bolted at sea.

I also declare that I propose to have the tank top ceiling and spar ceiling dispensed with if Lloyds will accept it, and under the condition that the centre plate be cemented level with the other plates of the tank top, the plate edges coated with cement and the tank top generally coated with tar and powdered with cement, and the spar ceiling replaced by vertical wood liners bolted on the frame edges to prevent cargo chafing on the angle flanges.
