Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter H & F. of the 6th November, 1947, in connection with Special Survey and Renewal Freeboard Survey on the "AUCHMACOY", and in reply to inform you that the Owners have requested me to proceed to Freetown and Berkhurst for that purpose.

I am therefore proceeding on the M.S. "ACORA" on the 4th instant and arriving at Freetown on the 8th instant, the vessel calls at Takoradi en route, and is in that port for eight hours, this will enable me to interview the Manager of the Gold Coast Railways in connection with the overdue surveys on their Tug "TITAN". I shall also interview the Owners of the "LORD GAINSFORD" at Freetown in respect of maintenance of class surveys.

I shall be away from Lagos approximately two and a half weeks and anticipate that I shall return by air. The air service is weekly and stops at Takoradi only half an hour which would preclude interviewing the "TITAN's" Owners.

The air passage takes two days between Lagos and Freetown.
