Crossley Bros. of Gorton, Manchester on March 12th 1917 and subsequent dates for the purpose of inspecting, during construction portions of the Machinery intended to be fitted on board the "Herring" class Admiralty Tender being built by Messrs. Cochrane & Co. of Leby, their Ship No. 217 and Engine C. 17. The Main Engines & Pumps driven by them together with the screw and intermediate shafts, Thrust block and other parts have been well constructed in accordance with the plans and specification, the material used having been satisfactorily tested to the requirements of Lloyd's Register of Shipping.
