Gentlemen,

I have to inform you that a first entry report on the steamer "FENTONIAN" has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Hull, from which it appears that this vessel has left for your port where it is stated her machinery is to be fitted, and in order to complete the survey on the hull, the following requires to be done, viz:- the engine and boiler casings and the deck in way of same to be lifted and finished, the fore mast to be fitted and the rigging to this mast and to the mizzen mast also to be fitted together with the trawl winch.

I shall therefore be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work forward a report on Form 8 for the information of the Committee, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
