
The s.s. No.3 became due 8-25 and a proposal to carry out same before the expiration of the year of grace was agreed to.



The Grimsby Surveyors now state that the vessel has recently been sold and in accordance with his customary practice the new Owner desires the vessel to be withdrawn from class.
