Gentlemen,

I have to acquaint you that it appears from a First Entry Report received from the Society's Surveyors at Hull that the S.S. "GLATIAN" recently built by Messrs. Cochrane & Sons has left Hull for your port, where it is stated her machinery is to be fitted.

In order to complete the survey on the hull the following requires to be done :- the engine and boiler casings and the deck in way of same to be refitted and finished, the fore mast to be fitted, and the rigging to this mast and to the mizzen mast also to be fitted together with the trawl winch.

I shall be glad if you will give this case the necessary attention and on completion of the work forward a report on form 8 in the usual manner for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.
